## **GCSE Results 2010**

### **STUDENTS ECSTATIC - BEST EVER RESULTS AT KING'S**



Students and staff were ecstatic having achieved the school's **best ever GCSE results** with 64% of all grades being at A\* or A grade. There were many spectacular performances with four students obtaining at least 9 A\* grades, Elizabeth Bell, Elizabeth Jessop, Rebecca Massie and David Ormrod Morley and Eleanor Strutt impressed with 11 GCSEs, 8 A\* and 3 A grades.

A staggering 34 students (21% of the year group) gained 9 straight A\*/A grades or better. Across the whole year group too there was much to celebrate as 99% of all GCSEs were at grades A\*-C.

## **A level Results - Thursday 19 August**

### **HIKMAT GAINS 4 A\*s**

The atmosphere was jubilant at King’s as students received their A level results this summer.



There were many notable successes within the exceptionally large year group of 153 students but Hikmat Hassan from Macclesfield, got top grades in each of his four A level subjects: Maths, Further Maths, Chemistry and Physics in addition to an A grade at AS for Biology.

Hannah Smith’s achievements were also remarkable. Hannah, from Knutsford, gained 5 A levels, 2A\* and 3 A grades in Maths, Further Maths, Chemistry, Physics and Economics.

In all 12 students gained 4 A\*/A grades or better and 32 students achieved 3 A\*/A grades or better. The outstanding standards of previous years was held with 75% of grades gained at A\*/B level. The A-C passes were also an impressive 93%.
